

Incoming 3rd Grade Student Summer Job

1. Incoming 3rd grade students should be able to write and read cursive handwriting. Make sure you practice your writing during the summer.
2. Each incoming 3rd grade student should have 3 book reports. Read the following instructions before doing your reports.

BOOK REPORT 1

Draw a front cover for your book, which includes:

- The name of the author and the title of the book
- The student's name
- Contains a drawing which is clearly related to the book, is original, colorful and creative
- 10 vocabulary words from the book, listing the page number where the word is found, the sentence that contains that word, a definition of the word and a sentence you creates which contains the word, used properly

BOOK REPORT 2

Setting – tell where and when the story took place

Main characters – list the main characters and write 2 or 3 sentences to describe them.

BOOK REPORT 3

Choose one of the above formats for Report #3

Legible handwriting is worth 25% of your grade.
